Stepping Stones to Professional Development and Achieving a Child Development Associate (CDA)

The following class may be used as the “**30-hour Child Development course**” currently required by the state for staff of a licensed center or as the **first** class in a series of four that may be used to fulfill the training hours required to achieve a CDA.

Child Development

Course Instructor: Heather Duhamel, Master Instructor

Course Description: This course analyzes (development) behaviors associated with the stages of child development including birth, infancy, childhood, and early adolescence. It examines patterns and theories of development and behavior. Included is the preparation of a case study of an individual child. **Prerequisites:** None

CDA Subject Areas: 1, 2, 3, 5, 7 and 8

Schedule: Wednesdays, 6-9 pm; for 10 sessions beginning September 2nd @ Burlington Children’s Space, 241 No. Winooski Avenue in Burlington.

Cost: \$175.00 This fee includes \$150 class tuition and a \$25.00 book deposit. The total \$175 fee must be paid in full one week prior to the start of the first class. The book deposit will be returned in full upon students turning their books back in to Child Care Resource. Students not returning books will be charged the price of their books beyond the \$25.00 deposit. The \$150.00 tuition fee is non-refundable after the first class.

College Credit: Students have the option of taking this class for 2 credits through Union Institute and University. In order to take this class for college credit, students must enroll with Union Institute and pay an additional \$196.00 before the start of classes. Enrollment forms will be sent with confirmation letters for your use if you choose the credit option. Please call Meghan at Ext. 40 if you have any questions about enrolling for credit.
