This annual report is a glimpse into our work over the past year. The images convey the deep meaning of the work we do every day for the thousands of Chittenden County children who depend upon the kindness and skills of parents, teachers, and caregivers. At Child Care Resource, we are dedicated to holding the best interest of these children at the heart of what we do because all children deserve a childhood filled with love, learning, and laughter.

What we achieved this year:

We helped families and providers make child care connections:

- 2096 child care searches completed
- Helped 1,300 families pay for child care for 2,100 children

We strengthened early learning opportunities:

- 88 programs collectively serving over 2,700 children received on-site consultation services.
- 905 child care workers participated in one or more workshop, course, or seminar.
- 326,435 meals made possible through our child care food program.

We created child care solutions for communities:

- Developed a network of home-based early care and education programs that now provide pre-kindergar ten education services in alignment with the Vermont Early Learning Standards under CCR supervision.
- Began the development of a comprehensive early childhood plan for the South Burlington School District.
- Developed child care food network for center-based early care and education programs.
